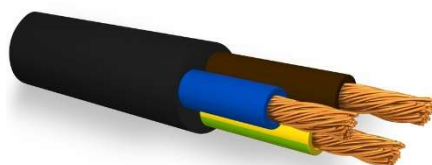

1. INTRODUCTION

This document represents the EPD study conducted for the product RUBBER CABLES – type H07RN-F manufactured by Pecso Cavi S.r.l., in accordance with the EPDItaly Program and its Regulations, developed in compliance with ISO 14025 and intended to provide a tool for the development, verification, and publication of Environmental Product Declarations.

The study was conducted in accordance with PCR 007 “Electronic and electrical products and systems” rev. 3.2 dated 12/10/2025, together with PCR 016 of the same program “Electronic and electrical products and systems – cables and wires” rev. 3 dated 10/03/2024, which identifies and documents the objective and scope of application of LCA-based information for the product category, the rules for generating additional environmental information, the life cycle stages to be included, the parameters to be addressed, and the manner in which the parameters must be collected and reported.

2. MANUFACTURER INFORMATION

Pecso Cavi was founded in 1979 with the production of wiring harnesses for electrical panels, followed shortly thereafter by the manufacture of single-core cables.

From the very beginning, promising commercial opportunities abroad became apparent, developing in parallel with the company’s entry into the domestic market.

The early 1990s marked a major turning point: the relocation and significant expansion of the production facility, the broadening of the product range (rubber cables were added to the existing PVC cable line), and the attainment of IMQ certifications as recognition of the products’ high quality standards.

In the years that followed, growth was steady and continuous, eventually reaching the current scale that allows Pecso Cavi to carve out a prominent position in national and international markets and rank among the top Italian manufacturers in the sector.

These are flexible power cables, rubber-insulated and enclosed in a circular rubber jacket, with specific fire-resistant properties.

The copper rod is delivered to the Pecsó Cavi plant, where it is rough-drawn and drawn. Once these processes are complete, the stranding operation takes place using stranding machines; this involves twisting together a certain number of copper strands of equal diameter to form a rope known as a strand. The strands obtained by passing the multifilament through the stranding machines are immediately sent to the primary insulation lines. Here, the copper strands are coated with rubber compound; the strand is pulled through the extruder head—the main component of the line—where the wire is coated with molten, which, once cooled, forms the primary insulation around the strand. Upon exiting the extruder head, the insulated wire passes through a vulcanisation line, that use steam and high pressure to to improve its physical and mechanical properties.

The semi-finished product equipped with this initial insulation is sent for stranding, an operation performed on special machines similar to stranding machines. To produce multi-conductor cables, the single-wire semi-finished cable undergoes mechanical stranding to form strands composed of a variable number of conductors.

The insulation is then covered with an additional layer of rubber material, the outer sheath. This process follows the same procedure as that used for core extrusion lines, with the difference that the extruders used are larger and have a higher capacity. Finally, the product moves on to packaging and shipping.

The following image shows the product flow chart:

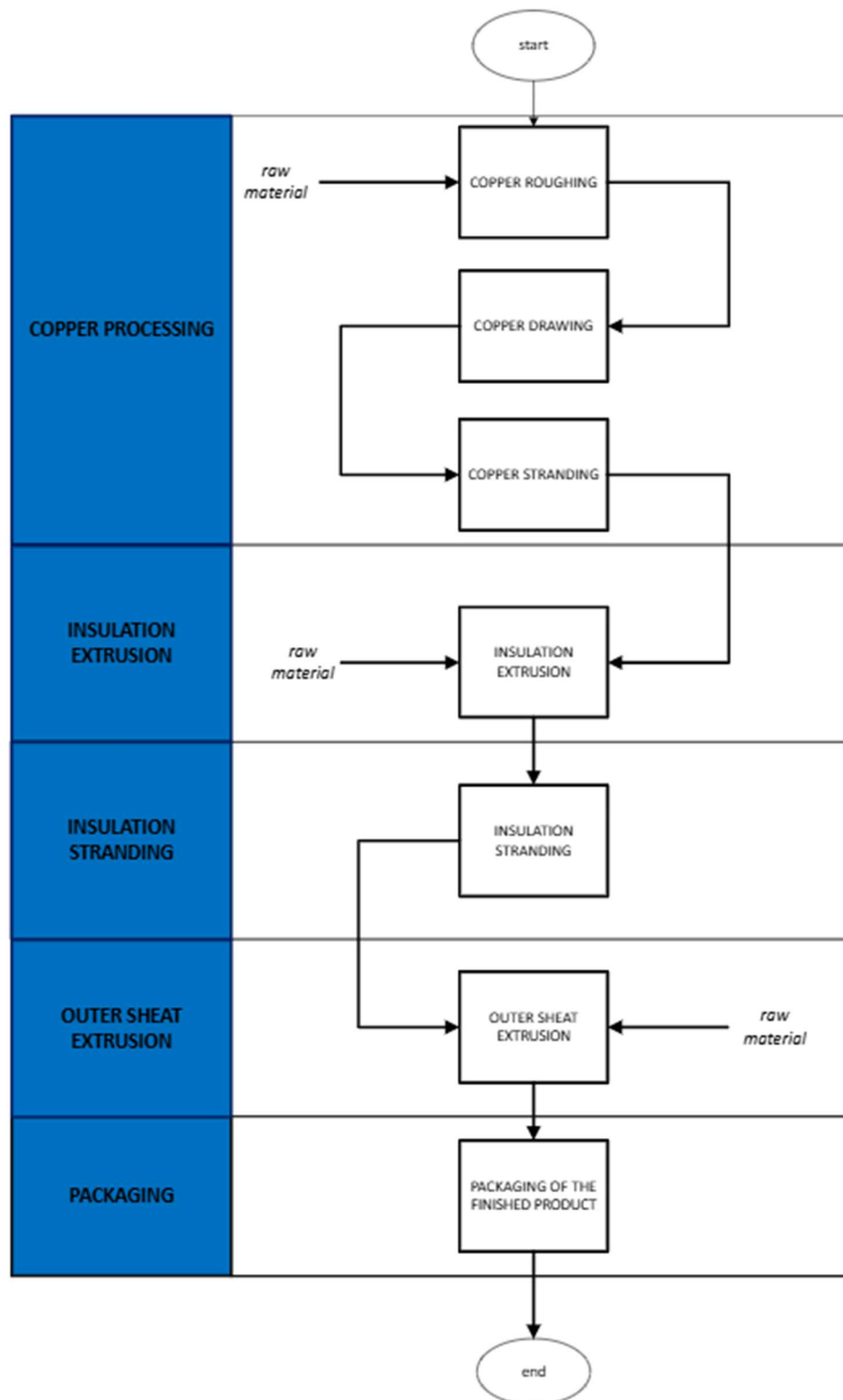


Figure 1. Flowchart

The product in question does not contain any substances included in the “Candidate List of Substances of Very High Concern for Authorization” under the European REACH Regulation, as published in the Official Journal on January 21, 2016.

4. INFORMATION ABOUT THE LCA STUDY

Given the scope of this “cradle-to-grave” study, the declared unit is based on the reference PCR and is **defined as 1 km of cable for all life cycle stages, with the exception of the use phase.**

The declared unit refers to 1 km of cable as produced by the manufacturer, without accounting for material losses that may occur during cable installation. Since the cable may operate at varying loads during its useful life, the use phase must be modeled using a functional unit of 1 km of cable with a load of 1 A.

The life cycle phases included in the study are schematically represented in Table 2. The approach takes into account “cradle-to-grave” boundaries and includes the following phases: Production, Distribution, Installation, Use, and End-of-life. For the installation phase, the following aspects were considered irrelevant and therefore excluded from the analysis: installation waste, general waste generated during installation, and any additional consumption of materials or energy occurring during the installation phase.

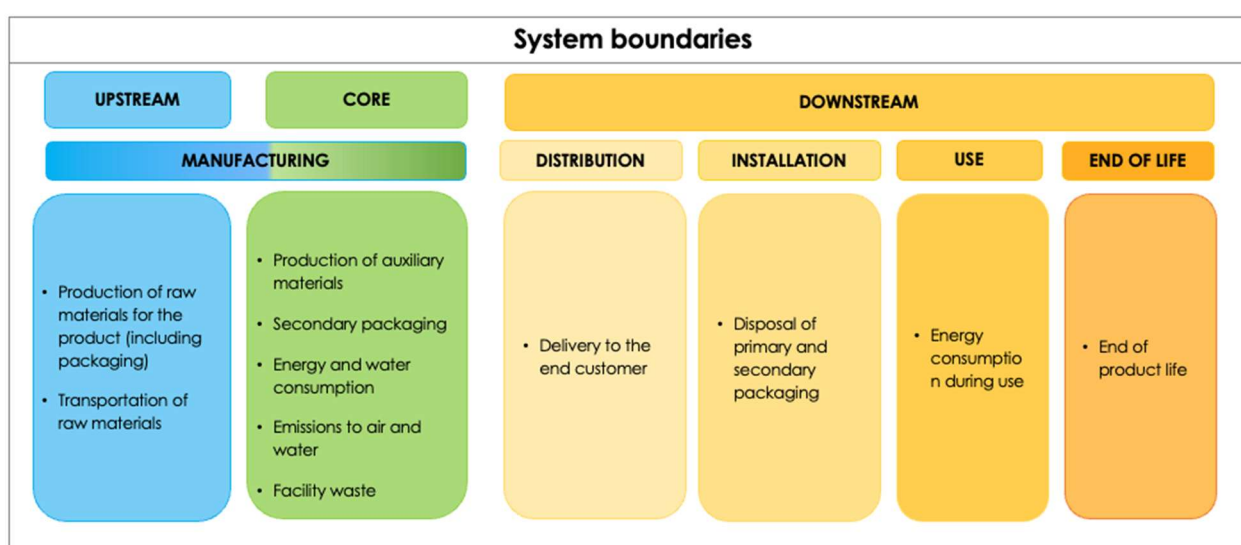


Figure 2. System boundaries

The LCA study was conducted in accordance with the UNI EN ISO 14040/14044 standards, following the guidelines of EN 50693:2019.

The software used for the impact assessment is SimaPro Developer 10.2.0.3; Ecoinvent 3.11 database. The methods used to calculate impacts are *EN 15804 + A2 (adapted) V1.01 / EF 3.1 normalization and weighting set* for calculating impact categories, *Cumulative Energy Demand (LHV) V1.01 / Cumulative energy demand* for the calculation of energy resource use and consumption, *Selected LCI results, additional V1.07* for water consumption, *EDIP 2003 V1.07 / Default for waste*.

The assessment of all the potential environmental impacts listed above is based on the life cycle of the product under analysis, taking into account production and disposal.

The following describes the elements and processes considered for the assessment of impacts related to each phase:

Manufacturing Phase	• Production of raw materials, including production and processing; • Electricity generation, including steam and heat derived from primary energy sources, including extraction, refining, and transportation; • Transportation to the production site, including both internal transportation and transportation of raw materials and packaging; • Product manufacturing process; • Packaging materials used; • Emissions to the atmosphere, including those from the combustion of primary energy resources and water discharges; • Production of auxiliary materials; • Treatment of waste generated by the manufacturing process; • The source of electricity used and modeled for the production site is based on the Italian residual mix, equal to 0.680 kg CO₂ eq/kWh (Ecoinvent 3.11).
Distribution Phase	• Transportation of the packaged product from the manufacturer's final logistics hub to the customer
Installation Phase	• Management of packaging waste at the installation site, including collection and processing through to final disposal.

Site-specific data were used for all of the following processes:

- production and transport of raw materials for the devices and packaging materials;
- manufacturing processes, facility energy consumption, atmospheric emissions, and waste;
- linear durability and RSL of the device;
- transport to the end customer.

Generic data were used for:

- recycling, energy recovery, and disposal rates for the finished product;
- waste transport.

The default scenarios described in the PCR EPDIItaly007 and PCR EPDIItaly016 documents were used for:

- Device current: 1 A.
